Personal Projects

FarsiNews: News Management System

FarsiNews "was" a simple content management system, which was written in PHP4 and used MySQL database to store its data. There was a bunch of similar projects out there, but the difference was that FarsiNews was actually in Persian language and it was optimized to be used inside of Iran. The project started in early 2005 and terminated early 2009 because of personal issues. Still so many people are using FarsiNews as they content management system, as it's simple and powerful.

Phoenix MVC Platform

Phoenix was supposed to be a Blogging Platform, but after I started the development, I realized, there are powerful blogging platform like WordPress and there is no point in designing another one with the same features, and I was about to terminate it, the I figured out that the framework I developed was so easy-to-use and easy-to-learn and powerful and I started to spend more time on it's development, It's been two and a half year since I started. Phoenix platform uses MVC methodology to run develop applications meaning that developers have to write their applications in three different stages: Modeling, Controlling and Presenting. Phoenix platform will be released late 2010 for public use. It's open source and based on GNU/GPL License.

Jalali Date/Time Class for php

I have developed an open source library as a wrapper for PHP 5.2's DateTime object, which adds "Jalali (Shamsi)" date and time support to php applications. This library is capable of calculating (and converting) dates up to year 9999 (unlike other Jalali libraries which support years up to 2038). This library is open source and easy to use, and really painless to use. This library supports php Time Zones and Jalali functions could be deactivated any time.
